STUDENT STAFF LIAISON COMMITTEE (SSLC)

SSLCs are where elected Class Representatives present their gathered student feedback to share with the wider UofG community. These work on providing insight and promoting dialogue to support and enhance student experience through partnership with colleagues.

COURSE EVALUATION QUESTIONNAIRE (EvaSys)

Course questionnaires open at the end of the semester via EvaSys, our course evaluation platform. We encourage all students to complete this mix of core and customised questions to maximise meaningful feedback on student experience.

SUMMARY AND RESPONSE DOCUMENT (SaRDs)

Summarise and highlight feedback students provide via the course questionnaire, and demonstrates how students' feedback is acted on. This student facing document shapes part of the discussion at the Student Staff Liaison Committee (SSLC).

WIDER DISCUSSION OPPORTUNITIES

Feedback can be given at any time, via student-staff meetings, discussion in class and could include, 'You said, We did' sessions.'

CLOSING THE FEEDBACK LOOP

Colleagues in your subjects, schools and colleges reflect on feedback from students, building a bigger picture of overall student experience at all levels. They will then take appropriate actions to address feedback, and report on these actions through a number of routes such as the next SSLC, via Moodle sites etc.'
