# Antiquarian published works/histories

- Robert Sibbald A collection of several treatises... concerning Scotland, as it was of old... Edinburgh: 1739 (Mu11-a.21)
- Johann Georg Keyssler **Antiquitates selectae septentrionales et Celticae** Hannover: 1720 (Mu2-y.12)

## Manuscript notebooks & papers of antiquarians/historians (including amateurs)

- Papers of Dr George Neilson. Archaeological notebook 1896-1898, with rough index of sites visited in South-West Scotland (MS Gen 1114d)
- Notebook of John Bell of Dungannon. Notes on artefacts, superstitions etc. Nineteenth Century. (MS Farmer 332)
- Robert McWhirter Notes on Ballantrae and environs. Notes on natural and local history of the parish of Ballantrae including plants, Kirk Session records, stone circles, local families, education, agriculture, antiquities, smuggling, Gaelic place names. (MS Gen 1523-41)

## **Historical correspondence**

• Letters from correspondents in Scotland to the antiquary George Chalmers, written during the 1790's. The letters served as the basis for Chalmers' **Caledonia**, published in London, 1807-24. (MS Gen 1521)
