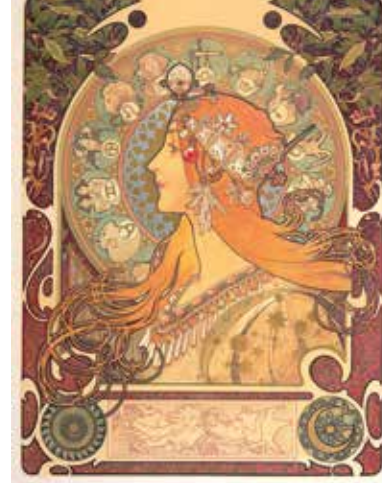

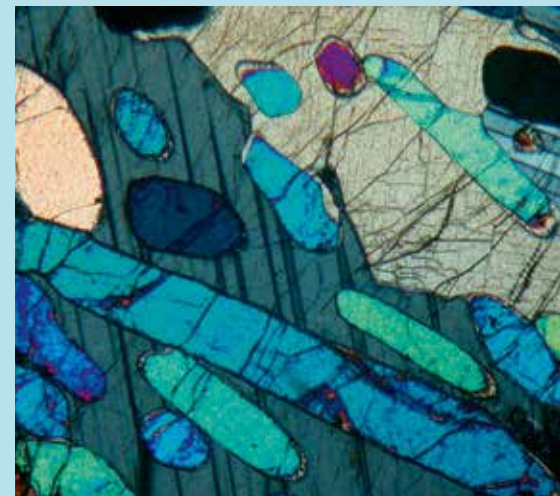
TURNER'S RHINE JOURNEY
