She has several non-executive roles; in particular, she is Chair of the Architecture Design Scotland Board; has recently become a member of the Scottish Futures Trust Board; she sits on the Scottish Executive of the BCO; and is also a member of the Construction Scotland Leadership Board.

Ann is a Trustee of National Museums of Scotland and also chairs its Estate Committee.

She is a member of Women in Property as well as the Association of University Directors of Estates.

Ann received a Regional Director of the Year award from the Scottish Institute of Directors in 2018, was awarded an MBE in the 2018 New Year Honours List for services to Higher Education and in February 2019 she received the Business Leadership Award at the Scottish Property Awards.
