Carnegie Trust Vacation Scholarships	Undergraduate students in their 3 rd year at a Scottish university (incl. RCS and GSA), on track to achieve a 2:1 or higher. Must be a citizen of the UK or EU, or have been granted permanent leave to remain in the UK/EU.	Independent research project of direct benefit to their academic work, from 2 to 12 weeks; research project can be carried out at your home university or elsewhere. Stipend: £250 per week.	The student must secure the support of a member of staff as a supervisor. Chapel Choir	All students at the university, subject to audition	The Chapel Choir normally organizes one international tour per year. Cross Trust Undergraduate Vacation Awards in the Arts	Undergraduate students in the Arts (broadly understood) of Scottish birth or parentage, of the highest academic merit and limited financial circumstances	To attend conferences, symposia, workshops or master classes, or to visit libraries, museums, galleries, concerts or centres of excellence in direct and demonstrable connection with their studies	Selection process opens in January each year; candidates to be selected internally by their own university, then applications submitted to the trust by April	https://www.thecrosstrust.org.uk

Francis & Marta Johnson Summer Scholarship	Music students making outstanding progress in year 2 or 3 of their degree		Awarded biennially on the recommendation of the Head of Music; students must submit a project proposal	Ask in Music
Merchants House Travelling Scholarship	Undergraduate students of the University of Glasgow who have completed the second or any subsequent year of study, or to graduates immediately following graduation. Preference given to students of Scottish parentage. Summer Schools	Undergraduate students in any subject	Summer schools in various subjects organized by UoG international partners throughout the world (see link for list of available universities). Fee-paying but some universities offer discounts to students from partner institutions and you can also apply for a scholarship through the Study Abroad office.
