The Dr Peter Davies Postgraduate Scholarship
Roinn na Ceiltis is na Gàidhlig | Celtic and Gaelic

B' e àrd-òraídiche ann am Fraingis, a tha a-nis air a dhreuchd a leigeil dheth, aig Oilthigh Ghlaschu a bha anns an Dr. Peter Davies. Ann an 2016, stèidhich an Dr Davies ciad Sgoilearachd Iar-Cheumnach an Dr Peter Davies ann an Sgoil nan Nuadh-chananan agus nan Cultaran (SMLC) – a' toirt £5,000 an urra airson dithis oilleanach sgoilearachdan gach bliadhna, far a bheil aonan dhiubh sin a' sgrùadhann ann am Fraingis.

Bho 2023/24, tha Dr Davies air a leigeil fhaicinn gum bu chaomh leis gum biodh na Sgoilearachdan air an leudachadh gus £5,000 an urra a thoirt do cheathrar oilleanach gach bliadhna. Thathar a' moladh gum bi trì dhe na sgoilearachdan sin air an tabhann do dh'oileanaich Maighstireachd le Rannsachadh ann an SMLC agus aonan do dh'aon oilleanach ann an Roinn na Ceiltis is na Gàidhlig.

Dr Peter Davies was a retired Senior Lecturer in French at the University of Glasgow. In 2016 Dr Davies established the inaugural Dr Peter Davies Postgraduate Scholarship in the School of Modern Languages and Cultures (SMLC) – awarding £5,000 each to two scholarship recipients annually, where one is studying French.

From 2023/24 Dr Davies has suggested he would like the Scholarships to be extended to award £5,000 each to four students per annum. It is proposed that three of these scholarships will be awarded to Masters by Research students from the SMLC and one from the subject Celtic & Gaelic.

1. Giorrachadh air an Sgoilearachd | Summary of Scholarship

Tha priomh mhion-fhiosrachadh Sgoilearachd Dr Peter Davies airson seisean 2023-24 mar a leanas:

The main details of the Dr Peter Davies for session 2023-24 are as follows:

- Thèid an Sgoilearachd a thairgsinn do dh'oileanach freagarrach a tha air cur a-steach, agus a gheibh àite, air prògram Maighstearachd iar-cheumnach ann an Ceiltis is Gàidhlig aig Oilthigh Ghlaschu | *The Scholarship will be awarded, subject to a successful application to a suitable student who has applied to postgraduate Master's programme in Celtic & Gaelic at the University of Glasgow.*

- Air an toirt do dh'oileanaich a tha a' toirt fianais gu bheil feum ionmhasail aca a dh'fhaodadh bacadh a chur orra bho bhith a' dèanamh an cuid rannsachaидh maighstireachd iar-cheumnach | *awarded to students evidencing financial need which could prevent them from undertaking their postgraduate research masters.*
- Faodar duais seisean 2023-24 a ghlèidheadh airson aon bhliadhna a-mhàin gus cobhair a thoirt do thagraiche(an) soirbheachail crìoch a chur air prògram Maighstireachd iar-cheumnach. | *The award for session 2023-24 is tenable for one year only to enable the successful candidate(s) to complete a Master's postgraduate programme.*
- Tha luach £5,000 anns an Sgoilearachd. | *The value of the Scholarship is £5,000.*

Mura tèid sgoilearan iomchaidh a chomharrachadh ann am bliadhna sam bith, cha tèid an duais a bhualeachadh agus bidh an t-airgead a chaidh a chomharrachadh airson na bliadhna sin a chur mu seach airson na h-ath bhliadhna [NO] ma bhios nas lughna triùir sgoilearan air an comharrachadh ann an SMLC no nas lughna na aon ann an Ceiltis is Gàidhlig, faodar sgoilearachdan nach deach a chleachdadh a thoirt dhan chuspair eile ma tha barrachd thagraichean iomchaidh ann. | *In the event of no suitable scholars being identified in any year, no award will be made and the funding set aside for that year will be awarded in a subsequent year [OR] In the event of fewer than three suitable SMLC scholars or fewer than one suitable Celtic & Gaelic scholar being identified in any year, the available scholarship may be awarded to the alternate subject if there is a surplus of suitable applicants.*

2. Riatanasan Neach-Glèidhidh na Duais | Requirements on Award Holders

Bidh na h-oileanaich air an tèid an Sgoilearachd a bhualeachadh ri aithisg ghoirid air an adhartas a chur gu Oifis Leasachadh agus Alumni aig ceann gach bliadhna acaideamaigeach agus thèid sin a chur adhart chun an tabhartaiche, agus bidh cuireadh aca gus coinneachadh ris an tabhartaiche ann an suidheachadh neo-fhoirmeil tron bhliadhna, agus aig lòn comharrachaидh san t-samhradh an dà chuid mar fheadhainn a tha a' faighinn taic agus mar fheadhainn a fhuair an taic san àm a dh'fhalbh.

Thathas ag iarraidh air neach-glèidhidh na Sgoilearachd taic bho Sgoilearachd An Dr. Peter Davies aithneachadh anns an tràchdas dhereannach aca agus ann am foillseachadh a thigeadh às an rannsachaидh iar-cheumnach maoinichte leis an Sgoilearachd.

The Dr Peter Davies Scholarship recipient will be required to submit a brief report on their progress at the end of each academic year to the Development and Alumni Office for onward transmission to the donor, and will be invited to meet the donor informally throughout the year, and at a celebratory lunch in the summer both as present and previous award holders.

The recipient of the Scholarship is requested to acknowledge support from the Dr Peter Davies Scholarship in their final thesis and in publications arising from the PG research funded by the Scholarship.

1. Cunntas Beatha slàn | *A full curriculum vitae.*
2. Litir-chòmhach a bhios a' mìneachadh carson a bu mhiann leibh gun d' rachadh beachdachadh oirbh airson na Sgoilearachd seo, ag innse mu thaic-airgid sam bith eile a fhuair sibh neo air an do chuir sibh a-steach a tha ceangailte ri ur prògram Maighstireachd iar-cheumnach | *A covering letter explaining why you wish to be considered for this Scholarship, detailing any other funding secured and/or applied for in connection with your postgraduate Master's programme.*
3. Tuairisgeul aithghearr air na cuspairean rannsachaidh anns an bheil ùidh agaibh andràsta agus an rùn agaibh airson dreuchd (mu dhuilleag a-màin) | *A brief outline of your current research and career interests (approx. one page).*
4. Dearbhadh air an inntrigeadh agaibh air prògram Maighstireachd ann an Ceiltis is Gàidhlig, neo brath gu bheil an t-iarrtas agaibh a' feitheamh air cead. | *Proof of your admission into a Master's programme in Celtic & Gaelic, or indication that your application is currently awaiting approval.*
